No. SOR (22) 37-S&GAD-2008. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 25 of the Balochistan Civil Servants Act, 1974 (IX of 1974), the Government of Balochistan is pleased to make the following rules prescribing the syllabus and other matters in respect of the departmental examination required to be passed by Balochistan Civil Services (Executive Branch) (B-17) Officers for promotion in BPS-18 namely:-

1. Short title and Commencement: These rules may be called the Balochistan Civil Services (Executive Branch) (B-17) Officers (Departmental Examination for Promotion to (BPS-18) Rules, 2008.

2. Definitions: (1) In these rules unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context, the following expressions shall have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:-

- (a) "Commission" means the Balochistan Public Service Commission.
- (b) "Examination" means the Departmental Examination of Balochistan Civil Services (Executive Branch) (B-17) Officers for promotion in BPS-18.
- (c) "Government" means the Government of Balochistan.
- (d) "Schedule" means, a schedule attached to these Rules.
- (e) "Subject" means a subject specified in the schedules.
- (f) "Post" means a post of Balochistan Civil Services (Executive Branch) (B-17).

2. Words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in Balochistan Civil Servants Act, 1974.

3. Promotion: No person shall be promoted in BPS-18 unless he passes an examination conducted by the Commission in the subjects specified by the Government and as amended from time to time.

4. Date and place of examination: The examination under these rules shall be held twice a year on the dates and at the place notified by the Commission in the official Gazette at least two months before such dates.

5. Authority for conducting examination: The examination under these rules shall be conducted by the Commission.

6. Qualifying standard: The qualifying standard for the examinations under these Rules shall be 50% of the maximum marks allocated to each subject. Candidates obtaining 60% marks shall be deemed to have passed that subject with credit.

7. Failures: No person who have failed in the examination thrice under these rules in any subject, shall be allowed to appear at a subsequent examination and thereafter no special chance shall be allowed.

8. Publication of result: After each examination, the names of those candidates who have passed the examination shall be published in the official gazette.

9. Number of papers: The examination shall comprise the following papers, each of 3 hours duration and consisting of maximum marks as noted against each:-

10. Syllabus: The papers shall be set up in each subject from the books prescribed by the Government, subject to modifications, if any, from time to time.

11. Revision of Syllabus: A Standing Sub-Committee consisting of the following members may review, after 5 years, the syllabus mentioned in Rule 11 and recommend its revision/ amendment to the Government in order to keep it upto date:-

| (3) | Secretary, Government of Balochistan,
Law Department; | Member. |
| (4) | A representative of the Commission. | Member. |

12. Permission to consult books: (1) The 1st, 2nd and 3rd papers in Criminal Law, the Jail paper, the paper in Civil Law, the 1st and 2nd paper in Revenue Law and the papers of Treasury and Local Government may be answered with the aid of bare copies of the relevant enactments and the rules.

(2) The questions answerable with the aid of books shall be so designed as would obviate the possibility of answering by copying a passage from a book in order to test the practical knowledge of the candidates and shall be confined as much as possible to cases arising in ordinary practice, facts of probable occurrence being stated and the candidates required to find and apply the law or rule bearing on them.

13. Provision of Text Books: It shall be the duty of the Commission to see that up-to-date copies of the reference books are available in the Commission for use of candidates who shall be allowed to consult the books.

14. Disqualification of candidate. Nothing shall be brought in writing by the candidates in the examination room nor any copying from the paper of other candidate shall be authorized in the Examination Hall. A candidate contravening this provision shall render himself liable to disqualification for appearing in the examination for a period of 3 years in future in addition to proceedings against him under the Balochistan Province Removal from Service (Special Powers) Ordinance 2000.

15. Exemption: (1) Any person who have attained/exceeded the age of 56 years shall be exempted from passing of departmental examination.

(2) The Officer having the Bachelor's Degree in Law shall also be exempted from appearing in those papers of the Departmental Examination which are part of the syllabus in LLB Examination.

Provided that no person shall claim any proforma promotion or other financial benefits retrospectively on the basis of such exemption.

Provided further that a person, who has been granted exemption from passing of departmental examination, shall earn at least two full calendar year ACRs before promotion to the next grade.

16. Repeal: The Balochistan Assistant Commissioners and Extra Assistant Commissioners (Departmental Examination) Rules, 1983, are hereby repealed.
