MOTIFICATION:

No.SOR(5)18/S&GAD-31. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 25 of the Baluchistan Civil Servants Act, 1974 (IX of 1974), the Government of Baluchistan ac pleased to make the following rules prescribing the syllabus and other datters in respect of the departmental examination required to be passed by the Assistant Commissioners and Extra Assistant Commissioners namely:

- 1. Short title and Commencement. These rules may be called the Baluchistan Assistant Commissioners and Entre Assistant Commissioners (Departmental examination) Rules, 1983.
- 2. <u>Definitions</u>. In these rules upless there is any-thing repugnant in the subject or context, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say in
 - [a] "Commission" means the Baluchistan Public Service Commission;
 - (b) "Commissions" means the Officer Incharge of a Revenue
 Division:
 - (c) "Chief Secretary" means the Chief Secretary to Government of Belightstan;
 - (d) "Deputy Commission mer" means the officer incharge of a revenue district and includes a Political Agent;
 - (e) "Bramination" means the deputimental evamination of Assistant Commissioners/Srtra Assistant Commissioners;
 - (f) "Government" means the Government of Baluchistan;
 - (h) "Probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a post of assistant Commissioners of Extra Assistant Commission r in accordance with the relevant service rules;
 - (g) "Post" means a post of Assistant Commissioners or Extra Assistant Commissioners
- 3. Confirmation of probationers. No Probationer shall be confirmed in a post unless he passes an examination conducted by the Commission in the subjects specified in Covt: Notification No.SO.II-33(6)/S&GAD dated the 19th December, 1972 and as amended from time to time.
- 4. Date & place of conination. The examination under these rules shall be held two a yet on the dates and at the places notified by the Commission in the fore such dates.

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- 5. Luthority for conjucting examination. The examination under these rules shall be conducted by the Commission.
- 6. Qualifying Standard. A candidate shall be deemed to have passed the examination if he obtains at least 50% of the maximum marks in each paper: Provided that a candidate who has passed the examination by the lower standard under the old rule, shall be deemed to have qualified the examination under these rules.
- 7. Failures. No person who has failed in the examination under these rules twice in the case of persons appointed by promotion and four times in the case of persons appointed by initial regruitment or by transfer, in any subject, shall be allowed to appear at a subsequent examination.
 - 8. Re-examination of failures. A person who fails to secure the minimum number of marks prescribed under Rule 6 in any paper may, subject to provisions of rule 7 appear in that paper at a subsequent examination.
 - 9. Publication of result. After each examination, the names of those condidates who have passed the examination prescribed standard shall be published in the Official Gazette.
- 10. Number of papers. The examination shall comprise the following papers, each of 3 hours duration and consisting of maximum marks as noted against each.

- 11. Syllabus. The papers shall be set up in each subject from the books prescribed therefor in the Notification Nc.SO.II-33(6)/S&GAD-72, dated the 19th December, 1972 subject to modifications, if any, from time to time.
- 12. Revision of syllabus. A standing Sub-Committee consisting of the following members may review, after every six months, the syllabus mentioned in rule 11 and recommend its revision/amendment to the Government in order to keep it uptodate;

- (1) Secretary, Government of Baluchistan Services and General Admn: Department.
- (2) Secretary, Government of Baluchistan, Law Department.
- (3) Member-I Board of Revenue, Baluchistan.
- (4) A representative of the Commission.
- 13. Permission to consult books. (1) The Fixst and Second papers in Criminal Law, the Jail paper, the paper in Civil Law, the First paper in Revenue Law and the papers of Treasury and Local Government may be answered with the aid of bare copies of the relevant enactments and the rules which shall be brought by the candidates themselves.
- (2) The questions answerable with the aid of books shall be so designed as would obviate the possibility of answering by copying a passage from a book in order to test the practical knowledge of the candidates and shall be confined as much as possible to cases arising in ordinary practice, facts of probale occurrence being stated and the candidates required to find and apply the law or rule bearing on them.
- (3) The third paper in Criminal Law and the Second paper in Revenue Law shall be answered without any aid what so ever, but copies of the Notifications, if prescribed, in the syllabus shall be supplied to the candidates for use in the examination.
- 14. Provision of Text Books. It shall be the duty of the Commission and the Deputy Commissioner/Political Agent to see that uptodate copies of the reference books are available in his office for use of candidates who shall allowed to consult the books.
- 15. Disqualification of candidates. Nothing shall be brought in writing

 by the candidates in the examination room nor any copying from the

 paper of other candidate shall be authorised in the Examination Hall. A

 candidate contravening this provision shall render himself liable to disqualification for appearing in the examination in future in addition to proceedings

 cation for appearing in the examination in future in addition to proceedings

 against him under the Baluchistan Civil Servants (Efficiency and Discipline)

 Fules, 1981.
- 16. Relaxation. Any of these rules may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, be relaxed by the Government in consultation with the Commission.
- 17. Repeal. The Rules of departmental Examination of "ssistant Commissioner/ Extra Assistant Commissioner and candidates for the post of Extra Assistant Commissioner 1933 are hereby repealed.
